**At Rennie Grove Peace Hospice Care we support people of all ages who are affected by a progressive life-limiting illness, and those who care for them, to live the best quality of life they can. Our care is provided at no cost to our patients and families, and while we receive a small proportion of NHS funding, we rely on the generosity of the local community to fund the majority of the costs of the service we provide.**

Our Vice Presidents' and Presidents' Circle programmes provide a committed and regular source of income to help support our overnight service. This vital service brings clinical relief at night to patients in the familiarity and comfort of their own homes as well as reassurance and emotional support for their family.

**“Having someone to turn to, who can help at that most distressing of times, is priceless.**

Dad was in a lot of pain and a Rennie Grove Peace nurse came out at 10pm to set up a syringe driver of morphine to get it under control. That allowed Dad to settle, and he died peacefully in the early hours of the next morning. When Dad died, the Rennie Grove Peace nurses came straight away and supported Mum by washing and dressing him. The exceptional care we received made such a huge difference to our experience at a terrible time.”

We are extremely grateful to our current Vice Presidents and members of our Presidents' Circle who help fund one of our specialist overnight team nurses. This service has long been established in the Buckinghamshire and west Hertfordshire areas and is vitally important to patients and their families helping them to feel less vulnerable and isolated when other healthcare services are closed.

Now for the first time, our overnight service is available in south west Hertfordshire, enabling us to care for even more patients and families in distress every night of the year.
